

# CITY OF FORSYTH CITYWIDE CLEAN – UP

## SATURDAY JUNE 8, 2019

Please read through this information carefully to ensure you meet the guidelines of this program

The Forsyth Citywide clean-up is Saturday June 8, 2018 and is only for residents inside the City of Forsyth. This program is being offered with the intent of providing residents the opportunity to clean their garage, basements, closets, and get rid of old worn out items and junk.

### CURBSIDE PICK-UP

Citizens must have their acceptable items at the curb (where trash cart normally sets) no later than 6:00 a.m. the morning of Saturday June 8, 2018 for pick-up.

- 1) Any non-acceptable items will be left at the curb for disposal by the resident.
- 2) Crews cannot access personal property to assist in moving items to the curb.
- 3) Clean-up will not take place at businesses, apartment buildings, or vacant homes
- 4) No construction/large remodel projects.

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Furniture – indoor/outdoor
- Beds/mattresses/large furniture – limit 2
- Clothes
- Television/Monitors/Microwaves
- Hand and small power tools  
(must be drained of oil & fuel)
- Weed eaters(must be drained of oil & fuel)
- Carpeting/padding (must be cut in 4' or  
Smaller sections) please keep to a max  
of 1-2 rooms
- Toys
- Basketball goals (must be broken down  
To 5'ft lengths)

### ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Tires/wheels
- Items over 6'ft length
- Propane tanks
- Appliances
- Large lumber or landscaping ties
- Construction/large remodeling
- Rocks,bricks, concrete
- Fluorescent/CFL/HID Bulbs
- Medical items (needles)
- Hazardous waste (including paint,  
Oil, aerosol cans, fertilizer, etc.)
- Brush/limbs/yard waste
- Bulk liquids
- Batteries
- No vehicle parts (motors,doors,hoods,  
Riding mowers, motorcycle, ATVs, etc)
