NUISANCE ENFORCEMENT DISCUSSION

Fire Chief Nathan Bower explained that the current ordinance concerning weeds states that the City Inspector is responsible for sending out letters concerning residents with weed control issues. Would like to have Fire Chief added to section to authorize Fire Chief to send out letters on weed control.

On a motion by Jack Baker and seconded by Cheryl Altis it was approved to have Fire Chief added to section 220.015.3 Motion carried with all members present voting aye.

BACKHOE DISCUSSION

Chris Robertson explained that received two bids for a backhoe. A John Deere from Murphy Tractor and Equipment for \$88,750.00 and a CAT backhoe for \$103,995.00. The backhoe will be purchased by a lease purchase program with Arvest Bank. Monthly payments will be \$1,500.00. The first payment to be \$3,000.00.

On a motion by Jack Baker and seconded by Clint Hilliard it was approved to accept the bid from Murphy Tractor and Equipment and purchase a John Deere backhoe in the amount of \$88,750.00

CHANGE ORDER TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT

On a motion by Cheryl Altis and seconded by Clint Hilliard it was approved to accept the change order from HDR Engineering on the treatment plant project in the amount of \$460.00. Motion carried with all members present voting aye.

The change order was for the electric work for the existing flow meter to work together with the new flow meter.

CHECKING ACCOUNT - FEMA FUNDS

Finance Officer Angela Leist explained that a non-interest bearing checking account was opened at Southern Bank for the funds received from FEMA to comply with FEMA requirements for the flood damage projects at the park and trail area.

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AGREEMENT

DISCUSS SPEED LIMIT IN TOWN

The Mayor explained that he has had request that the speed limit be lowered in town to 30 mile per hour. Police Chief Roger Ellis to have information on traffic observations and traffic counts for the next meeting for discussion.

DISCUSS OLD FIRE TRUCK 1 – OPTIONS TO SELL

Fire chief Nathan Bower presented the board with several options available to sell the current ladder truck. Will be getting the new truck soon and will start preparing it for service.

On a motion by Jack Baker and seconded by Clint Hilliard it was approved to use Purple Wave Auction Service to sell the current ladder truck. Motion carried with all members present voting aye.

BRIDGE DISCUSSION

On July 22, 2016 Jack Baker and Chris Robertson met with Mary Slaughter and Kristi Bachman with MODOT concerning the new bridge.

Campground 2 will need to be closed during the project and MODOT will compensate the City for camping fees lost during that time. Will need to have a temporary dump station while the campground is closed.

MODOT estimates the cost of the bridge project to be 7 million dollars.

Travis Hieir with HDR explained that Taney County is in the process of working out a cost sharing agreement with MODOT on a roundabout.

RESOLUTION 8-16-16

Finance Officer Angela Leist explained that this resolution is required by the credit card company to cancel the current city credit cards since we have started the purchase card program.

On a motion by Cheryl Altis and seconded by Clint Hilliard it was approved to accept resolution 8-16-16. Motion carried with all members present voting aye.

PARK BOARD UPDATE

Brian Anton explained that have three teams signed up for fall softball. Explained that Jack Harrison would like permission from the Board of Alderman to speak with the Taney County Park Board about getting some help with labor and sharing cost of work at the park.

On a motion by Brian Anton and seconded by Jack Baker it was approved to have Jack Harrison talk with the Taney County Park Board about help with labor and sharing cost of work at the park. Motion carried with the following votes: Cheryl Altis, aye, Jack Baker, aye, Brian Anton, aye, and Clint Hilliard, abstain.

Brian Anton presented the board with a current diagram for development of Shoals Bend Park.

On a motion by Jack Baker and seconded by Clint Hilliard it was approved to go ahead with the current plan as presented. Motion carried with all members present voting aye.

On a motion by Brian Anton and seconded by Clint Hilliard it was approved to appoint Greg Dougherty to the Forsyth Park Board. Motion carried with all members present voting aye.
